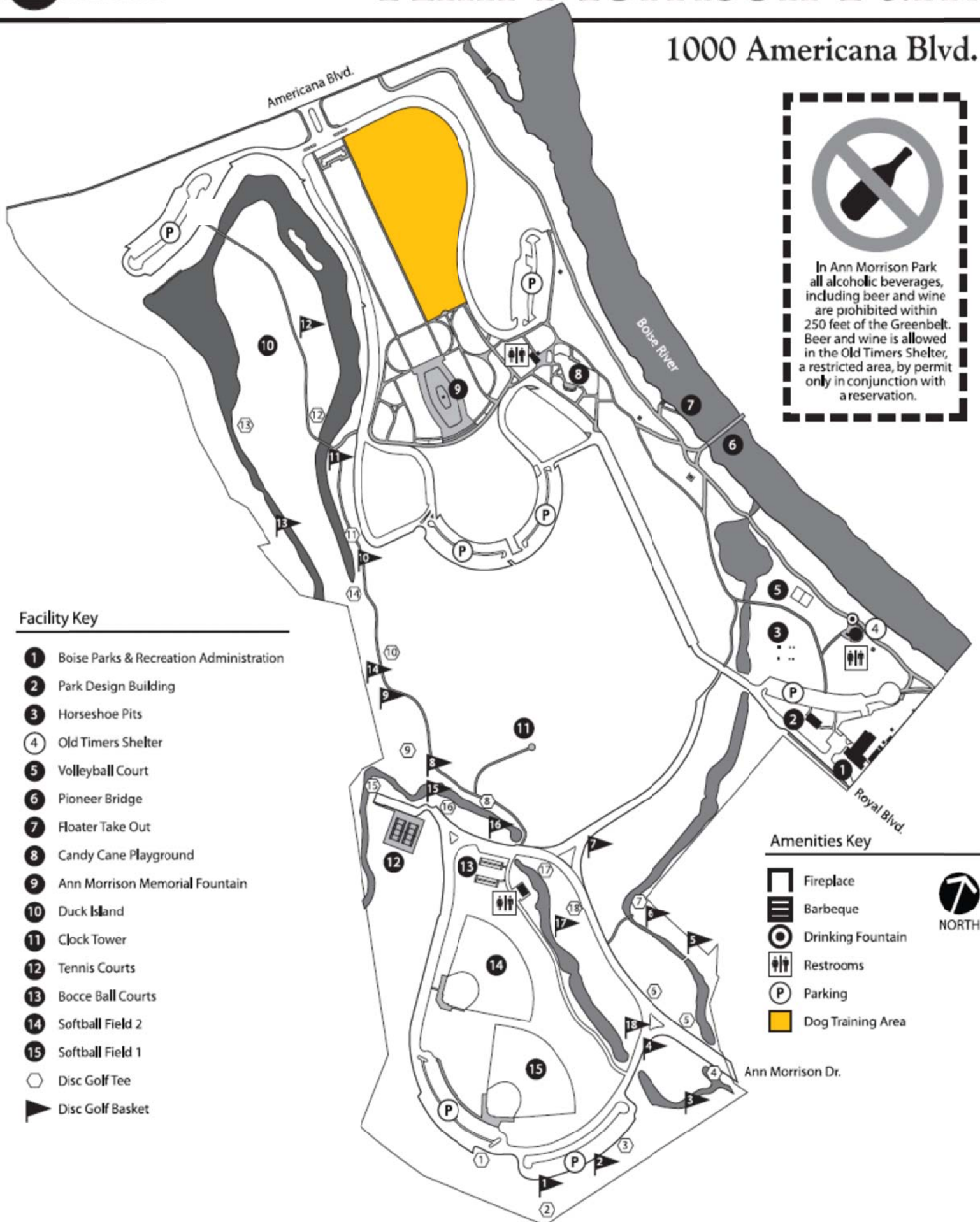
(153 Acre Urban Park)

Ann Morrison Park is the largest developed urban park maintained by Boise Parks & Recreation. It is located immediately south of the Boise River, with entrances off of Americana Blvd, west; Capitol Blvd to the east, accessed by Ann Morrison Drive and Royal Blvd.

- RESERVABLE:** Old Timer's Shelter, Fountain, Disc Golf Course (Private Rentals or Special Events)
- CAPACITIES:** Shelter - 500/seating capacity 90; Fountain - 500; Disc Golf Course - 500; Total Park Capacity 2500
- PICNIC FACILITIES:** Old Timer's Shelter is located on the northeast end of the park. Easy access to the river and the Greenbelt. The playground cannot be observed from this area.
***BEER/WINE and/or AMPLIFIED SOUND PERMITTED WITH RESERVATION AND PERMIT ONLY**
BBQ: One (1) 4' grill located near shelter
Parking: **Parking lot between the Parks and Recreation Building and Old Timer's Shelter is Parking by Permit only, Monday thru Friday from 7:30a.m.-5:30p.m.** All paid Old Timer's Shelter reservations for Monday thru Friday from 7a.m.-11a.m. and/or noon-4p.m. will be issued 15 parking permits.
Power: Two (2)-110v outlets with one (1)-20 amp breaker; Lighted facility.
Tables: Ten (10)-8' x 2'4" seating tables; two (2)-8' serving tables; Concrete slab with dividing wall down the center.
Water: Drinking fountains; No Hose Bibs.
- FOUNTAIN:** Ann Morrison Fountain operation is weather sensitive. No guarantee that the fountain will be working during event times. Ann Morrison Fountain is scheduled for Special Events only, otherwise it may be used as drop in use.
Power: Eight (8) GFI-110v outlets with four (4)-20 amp breakers; located on the light poles. (Open sunrise to sunset)
- DOGS:** All dogs must have current license with City of Boise. All dogs are required to be on leash in an area, unless otherwise indicated. Leash shall not exceed eight (8) feet in length within 250 feet of the greenbelt. Owners are required to clean up dog waste. Dogs may not harass humans or other animals.
- DOG OFF LEASH (DOLA):** **All areas east of the Fountain are off-leash use from November 1st – February 28th.**
- DOLA TRAINING AREA:** **Northwest Corner, Year Round Availability by permit only.**
- OTHER FACILITIES/**
Drinking Fountains: Softball diamonds near backstops, Candy Cane Playground; Old Timer's Shelter on the backside of the shelter.
Tables: Picnic tables are also scattered throughout the park for drop in users.
BBQ: 4BBQ's throughout the park.
Playground: On north side of park near river; equipment appropriate for ages 2-12.
Recreation: Two (2) lighted softball fields, eight (8) soccer fields, two (2) tennis courts and a nine (9) hole disc golf course located in the southeast corner of the park. Four (4) bocce courts are available by reservation or on a first come, first served basis. One (1) sand volleyball court and three (3) horseshoe pits located in the Northeast corner of the park. Besides the Greenbelt, there is approximately 2.26 miles of pathway around the perimeter of the park.
- RESTROOMS:** **Candy Cane Playground:** Two (2) stalls each for men and women plus one (1) ADA accessible stall. Operated on photo cell, open year round & lighted.
Shelter: One (1) stall each for women and men and one (1) ADA accessible stall. Operated on photo cell, open mid-April to mid-October.
Softball diamonds: One (1) stall each for men and women, plus, porta-toilets during the summer months. Operated on photo cell, restrooms are not lighted & only open mid-April to mid-October.
- PARKING:** Approximately 840 spaces (23 are ADA accessible, 91 regular spaces are along the roadways through out the park.) **Parking lot between the Parks and Recreation Building and Old Timer's Shelter is Parking by Permit only, Monday thru Friday from 7:30am-5:30pm.** All other parking is limited to designated areas and is available on a first come first serve basis.
NOTE: Vehicles parked in NO PARK areas will be towed at owners risk and expense. Boise Valley Towing 389-9707.
- *Accessible Areas:** Rest rooms and drinking fountain at Candy Cane Playground; Rest rooms at the Royal Blvd. entrance; drinking fountains at the playground and the shelter; picnic tables and parking stalls at Old Timers Shelter; Tennis courts and most designated pathways and greenbelt access. Accessible parking is available at the shelter (east end of park) and by Candy Cane Playground.

In Ann Morrison Park all alcoholic beverages, including beer and wine are prohibited within 250 feet of the Greenbelt. Beer and wine is allowed in the Old Timers Shelter, a restricted area, by permit only in conjunction with a reservation.
