

KRISTIN ARMSTRONG MUNICIPAL PARK

500 S Walnut St

(15 Acre Special Use)

Kristine Armstrong Municipal Park is located on the Boise River just southeast of downtown; south of Warm Springs Road and east of Park Boulevard, next to Idaho Fish & Game. (East on Warm Springs Ave., Right on Walnut St., park is on the left side of the street).

NO DOGS ALLOWED

PARK HOURS: Sunrise to sunset

RESERVABLE: One (1) shelter and ten (10) picnic areas available for private reservation 2nd Saturday in April through 2nd

Sunday in October. Reservation blocks: 7a-11a, noon-4p and 5p-sunset

CAPACITY: Total park capacity 2000/150 per site

FACILITIES: SHELTER - 150/seating 75; two (2)-18' and two (2)-20' picnic benches; one (1)-12' kids seating and one (1)-9'

serving - all are permanent, in concrete slabs. 4' grill. Lighted facility; Drinking fountain in vicinity

SILVER MAPLE #1 -150/seating 60; three (3)-27' picnic benches; one (1)-12' serving in concrete slab. Stone

fireplace available for cooking

CHESTNUT #2 - 150/seating 60; three (3)-20' picnic benches; one (1)-10' serving; concrete slabs. Stone

fireplace with double BBQ grills (approx. 6' long x 2' wide)

WILLOW #3 - 150/seating 60; three (3)-20' picnic benches; one (1)-12' serving, in concrete slab. Fireplace with

double BBQ grills (approx. 6' long x 2' wide)

SWEET GUM #4 - 150/seating 60; three (3)-20' picnic benches; one (1)-12' serving, in concrete slab. Double

BBQ grill for cooking (approx. 6' long x 2' wide)

SUGAR MAPLE #5 - 150/seating 60; ten (10)-6' picnic benches (no concrete slab). Stone fireplace with

double BBQ grills (approx. 6' long x 2' wide).

POPLAR #6 - 150/seating 60; three (3)-20' picnic benches; one (1)-10' serving in concrete slab. Stone fireplace

with double BBQ grills (approx. 6' long x 2' wide)

ASH #7 - 150/seating 60; three (3)-20' picnic benches; one (1)-10' serving in concrete slab. Stone fireplace

with double BBQ grills (approx. 6' long x 2' wide)

BURR OAK #8 - 150/seating 60; three (3)-20' picnic benches and one (1)-10' serving in concrete slab. Stone

fireplace with double BBQ grills (approx. 6' long x 2' wide). Drinking fountain

PIN OAK #9 - 150/seating 50; nine (9) 3'x3' pedestal tables in concrete slab. Double BBQ grills (approx. 6' long

x 2' wide)

LINDEN #10 - 150/seating 50; eight (8) 3'x3' pedestal tables in concrete slab. Double BBQ grills (approx. 6' long

x 2' wide)

AMENITIES: AMPLIFIED SOUND PERMIT - allowed with shelter reservation. Only one sound permit is issued per day. Up to

four (4) hours may be issued between 11am to 8pm. Fee \$20

BBQ - each site is equipped with BBQ

BEER/WINE PERMIT - required for possession of more than 7.5 gallons; however, the following sites: Shelter,

Sweet Gum #4, Poplar #6 and Ash #7 requires reservation and permit for any quantity. Fee \$10

DRINKING FOUNTAINS - four (4) located throughout the park

PLAYGROUND - located between ball field and shelter/parking lot, designed for ages 2-12; swing set

POWER - all sites have four (4)-110v outlets with 20 amp breakers at each site, except site #7, which has two (2)-110v outlets. Located just northeast of the shelter are the amplified sound barrier walls. These are

equipped with two (2) - 110v outlets with 20 amp breakers. Shelter has automatic lights

RECREATION - one (1) softball diamond (available on first-come, first-serve basis), birding, Boise River and Greenbelt, and MK Nature Center. Four (4) bocce courts are available by reservation or on a first come, first

served basis.

TABLES: picnic benches are scattered throughout the park for drop in use

RESTROOMS: Three (3) for women and men at each location. **SHELTER** operated on photo cell, open year-round.

PLAYGROUND Operated on photo cell, open from the 2nd Saturday in April through the 2nd Sunday in

October

PARKING: Approximately 296 spaces. Seventy-one (71) designated regular parking, five (5) are ADA accessible and

two hundred twenty (220) spaces are on the roadway throughout the park. Parking limited to designated areas. VEHICLES PARKED ILLEGALLY, NO PARKING AREAS OR LEFT IN PARK AFTER SUNSET MAY BE TICKETED AND/OR TOWED AT OWNERS' RISK/EXPENSE. CONTACT PARKING ENFORCEMENT 208.972.8150 OR BOISE
